Since joining the Laurus Trust in 2016, our school has received a huge range of support in terms of the school site, opportunities for developing staff and the sharing of teaching and curriculum expertise to name but a few.

We have also benefitted from working alongside colleagues in our two other Laurus Primaries in Cheadle Hulme and Woodford. From September we are welcoming two additional Primary Schools to the family - Crown Street Primary in central Manchester (which is opening as a new school beginning with Preschool and Reception classes) and we are also very excited to announce the addition of Hazel Grove Primary School to the Trust.



Hazel Grove Primary will be the first fully established Primary to join Laurus and we are looking forward to learning from the great practice that exists there as well as sharing our own approach with their team. We have been liaising with colleagues at Hazel Grove for many months including full due diligence exercises (both educational and non-educational) to ensure the schools are sufficiently aligned to make this a positive match in the interests of both school communities.

The addition of Hazel Grove will bring a small change to my role. Whilst I will still be Head of School at Gorsey, I will also be supporting Hazel Grove Primary in an Executive Head capacity. This will involve me spending time at Hazel Grove each week during which time Gorsey will be in the very capable hands of Mrs Bell and the rest of our brilliant Leadership Team. Hopefully it goes without saying that we all remain absolutely focused on driving Gorsey forwards to ensure our pupils have the very best primary education we can offer.

I will look forward to sharing further updates on the continued partnership working across the Laurus Primary Schools from September.
