After a really successful trial last year in one of our other Trust schools, this year we will be moving away from our use of Twitter/X and instead making use of Instagram to share and celebrate what your children are doing in school.

Instagram will be used to post pictures and short videos of school life in Years 1-6 (Reception will continue to use Tapestry for this purpose) and we would love as many of you as possible to engage in this as a window into the school.

Each year group feed will be a closed account with the staff here only admitting followers who have both requested this in the app itself and submitted their own details via the online form which is being sent out via MCAS for an extra layer of security. Please allow a little time after the break for your account to be accepted.

Class Teachers are aware of the children who do not have permission to appear on social media but we would also encourage parents to check the permissions they currently have set on MCAS to ensure they are correct.
